

AIMS Equipment Service

Tattooing places extreme stresses on critical components of a tattoo machine (front/back springs, contact point and capacitor). Over time the performance of these components will decrease and fail. Tattooing with a malfunctioning tattoo machine results in light tattoos, tattoo fading, slower tattooing speeds, and longer tattooing sessions.

A well-maintained tattoo machine makes tattooing easy and is critical for producing permanent tattoos.

AIMS tattoo machines should be serviced after each 12-month period.

AIMS equipment service includes a thorough machine cleaning along with an inspection of all solder connections. The performance of the front/back springs, capacitor, and contact screw are evaluated and replaced as needed. The needle tube is cleaned and inspected for linearity and pigment holding integrity. Each machine is then calibrated and certified to optimal operating standards for animal tattooing.

Machine service is easy to obtain.
